**As is customary we started with three whites.**

1. Contesa Pecorino, Italy, 12%, RRP £10.50 we paid £9.50
2. Roberto Sarotto Gavi Di Gavi, Italy, 12.5%, RRP £18, we paid £13.50
3. Dlz-Idealysta Chard Fiano, Italy, 12.5%, RRP £13.50, we paid £12

Voting was 2, 10, 7 – The Gavi Di Gavi being the clear winner and unusually the most expensive.



**Onto the reds:**

1. Bardolino Doc Cant'Garda, Italy, 12%, RRP £10.50, we paid £9.50
2. Fazi Battaglia Montepulciano amp, Italy, 13.5%, RRP £12.50, we paid £10.50
3. Costarossa Primitivo, Italy, 14%, RRP £16, we paid £13.50

The Voting was 1, 3, 15 - once again the most expensive red was the clear winner.

All the wines were purchased at Majestic.

Once again, a thoroughly enjoyable evening was had by one and all.
