

**1. Pinot Grigio, Friuli Grave, Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Italy 2021**  
**£6.59**

This wine is from a cool climate wine region near the Alps in north east Italy.

It should taste of crisp green apple, pear with a hint of white flowers, high acidity and a clean finish. To enjoy on its own, yet also versatile enough to go with light fare such as salads, white fish and grilled shrimp. A blend of Pinot Grigio and Pinot Gris.

**2. K Vine Chardonnay Evergreen Vineyard 2020**  
**£13.29 discounted to £11.99**

This wine is from the Evergreen Vineyard in Washington State USA.

This is a silky, smooth wine with aromas and flavours of pear, apricot and mango; with plenty of lemon, lime and tropical fruit. It's pleasing but actually a bit Sauvignon Blanc like, which we weren't expecting in a Chardonnay. It ends dry with good length, a touch of toasty oak and lingering lemon notes. Goes well with pasta, white fish, chicken and cheeses.

#### **.4. ALAZAR – MALBEC-ARGENTINA -Year Unknown**

This wine can be kept for many years & is suited to savoury red meat dishes especially dishes that include spice.

#### **5. LYME BAY - PINOT NOIR - ENGLISH 2020**

**£24.33**

Intense on the nose, red fruit combines with smoky vanilla & mild tobacco overtones.

On the palate red stone fruit notes of cherry & plum blend with blackcurrant, strawberry & toasty oak to give a rich, but balanced weight on the palate & a mouth-watering finish that lingers & evolves.

#### **6. PICCINI MEMORA –ITALIAN – 2019**

**£7.00 normally £8.50**

The EU wine classification VINO d'Italia allows, for the first-time table wines from more than Italian region to be blended together & sold under one label

The Piccini family have taken wines from the furthest regions of Italy. Venetian Merlot:Primitivo from Puglia: the heel of Italy, Sicilia Nero d'Avola & Montepulciano from mid region Abruzzo. Hence the compass as the label on the bottle.

Aromas of cherry, chocolate covered raisins & a hint of tobacco flavours with a sweet edge of dried cherries. Reminiscent of Grahams 2015 late bottled port
